## THE AKEHURST-ER "GET-TOGETHER"

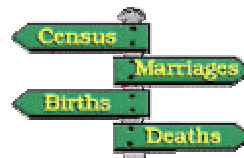
The A(c)(k)(e)(h)urst Family of Researchers held a "Get-Together" on Sunday 28<sup>th</sup> June 1998 at Hailsham, Sussex. The objects of this meeting of "great minds" were as follows:

- Meet socially "face to face" with as many A(c)(k)(e)(h)urst researchers as possible.
- Consider the various means of communicating with other researchers, together with a demonstration of Genealogy Resources on the Internet. This was to include a visit to the various Akehurst Internet Sites.
- Have Lunch together to enhance "face to face" relationships.
- Exchange information on all facets of our researching. eg. family tree programs, compiled databases. The idea here was to bring along photocopies of family trees and copies of other research material to swap with fellow researchers.
- Specific enquiries from individual researchers relating to their specific areas of interest.
- A general discussion to determine the overall goals required by researchers. eg. One Name Study approach, the future of the "AKEHURST-ER" Newsletter and the formation of an Akehurst Family Society to cater for the variant spellings that occur.

Invitations had been sent out to all known researchers in the United Kingdom, United States of America, Australia and New Zealand.

Non-UK researchers included David Murdock from the USA, Liz Rushton, David Evans and Colin Ackehurst from Australia.

## WHERE DO WE GO NOW?

The researchers at the "Get-Together" believed that it was necessary to carry out the following actions to best further the interests of all Akehurst researchers. "Volunteers" were invited to accept responsibility for carrying out specific actions.

1. **Formation of an Akehurst Family Society:** *David Brown*

To be called the **AKEHURST ONE NAME SOCIETY**. It was decided that a further meeting should be held in say 12 month's time to allow a steering committee to be formed to set up the Society.

2. **List of Researchers:** *Colin Akehurst and David Evans*

Update listing of postal and e-mail researchers. Follow up with online mailing list to encourage all researchers to participate

3. **G. O. O. N. S.:** *David Evans & Colin Akehurst*

David Evans to apply for membership of the Guild of One Name Studies (GOONS). When information becomes available, post a summary of arrangements on the Web Site.

4. **Keeper of Family Trees:** *Morwenna Akehurst*

Morwenna to determine best means of acquiring new trees and of disseminating information to researchers.

5. **Registrar of Documents Researched:** *Judith & Richard Akhurst*

Monitor Documents researched. Mail results to David Brown for inclusion on the Web Site, updated say every quarter?

6. **Keeper of Web Site:** *David Brown & David Murdock*

David Brown to modify and update Site as required. David Murdock to assist and to keep copy of site for back up purposes.

7. **Akehurst-er Newsletter:** *David Brown & Continental Cuzins*

David Brown to co-ordinate the preparation of the next edition (Issue 4), to be posted electronically on the Web site. Paper copies of the Newsletter to be prepared by the Continental Cuzins for circulation by them to the non-Internet researchers in the various continents.

Liz Rushton to co-ordinate edition Issue 5.

8. **Keeper of Strays:** *Bert Parsons*

Bert Parsons accepted this task. Clarification is needed on the term Strays - is it a list of individuals found outside their home parish or outside their home county?

9. **Surnames to be researched for the Akehurst Family Society and the One Name Study:**

## THE GOONS!

Not the BBC Radio Show but the Guild of One Name Studies (G.O.O.N.S.)!!

The Guild is the international society for everyone interested in one-name studies. Members may if they wish register surnames of which they are conducting a one-name study.

Since the formation of the Guild in 1979, a Register (of surnames & members) has been maintained. The main purpose of the Register is to enable individuals who specialise in researching specific surnames to have their interests on record. Only one person may register a given surname.

David Evans has applied for and obtained membership of the Guild which has about 1500 members worldwide and 6000 registered surnames (including variants). David has registered the surname AKEHURST plus four variants (the maximum number allowed):

### **Akehurst, Ackhurst, Akehurst, Akhurst, Akurst**

The registered surname of AKEHURST has initially been given a "C" category by David to indicate the level of the research on the name. This is defined as:

Surname for which the member has started a one-name study but has not yet built up a significant collection, but fully intends to acquire sufficient data to transfer to Category A or B. The member may or may not produce a newsletter.

David Evans and Colin Akehurst will maintain the One Name Study for the benefit of all Akehurst researchers.

The Guild's Register becomes a starting point for investigation and new Akehurst researchers will have a point of contact to get them involved in Akehurst research.

Morwenna Akehurst is the “Keeper of the Family Trees” and researchers are requested to send their family trees to her for recording purposes and to allow for retrieval of information to satisfy queries from other researchers.

## Obituary for Arthur Akehurst

Sadly we have to report that Arthur Akehurst passed away on the 15<sup>th</sup> January 1999 at the Eastbourne Hospital. Arthur was present at the Get-Together, with his brother Peter and Arthur's son, Gary.

Arthur contributed to the success and enjoyment we all felt at the Get-Together. Arthur explained to us all how to pronounce the Sussex and Kent place names. Arthur tried to keep a straight face, while slowly shaking his head, whenever the names were said with an Aussie accent.

Arthur was a member of the Hellingly Home Guard in 1940 (he was just too young for the armed forces but later was conscripted into the Rifle Brigade, was involved in the second day of D Day [Sword Beach with the Canadians] and later was badly wounded in the Battle of Caen in Normandy and invalided home.

Gary advised that the family held a family "get-together" after the funeral, in the Sussex Room at Boship Farm Hotel where the Akehurst "Get-Together" was held.

What is now known as the Sussex Room was his Home Guard barracks/guard room. One night a large tree fell around the room but not one person heard it (they were fast asleep after a drinking spell) so it held memories for him!!

Arthur will be sadly missed by his family and by all those who met him.

## Register Of Documents Researched

One of the actions arising out of the Get Together was the appointment of a "Registrar" whose role is to keep track of the Indexes, databases and other information that has been collected by individual researchers.

The objective of the Register is to enable all researchers to determine where to find research documents which are held by other researchers and thus to minimise duplication of research effort.

### Documents Researched

The term " Documents Researched " has been used as an overall term to include all types of research information obtained by Akehurst researchers in their family history research on the Akehurst surname, and its variant spellings

### Role of Registrar

Akehurst researchers will be asked to provide summaries of their Documents Researched to the Registrar. It is not intended that the Registrar should actually obtain or hold the original Research Documents.

The Registrar will ensure that summaries of all available Documents Researched, or currently being researched, are listed in the Register on the Akehurst-er Web Site.

The detailed information in the "Documents Researched" will only be made available:

1. Directly from contact with individual researchers who hold research documents OR
2. Downloaded from the Akehurst-er Web Site (computer databases)

To ensure that Akehurst researchers without Internet facilities are able to gain access to the Research Documents, a Register listing of available Documents Researched will be published, and regularly updated, in this Newsletter. (See attached Register)

Betty carried out an enormous amount of work that has been invaluable. We need now to extend her good work and to list the entries for the other variant spellings that occur.

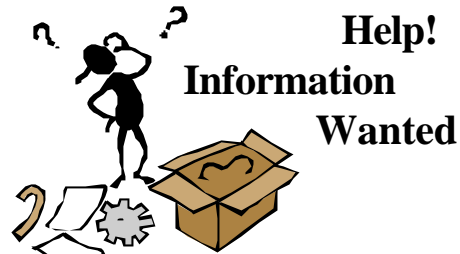
